Title: Somos | Neustar Transition - NANPA, PA, and RNA Update

On October 10, 2018, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) awarded Somos, Inc., a leading provider of trusted, neutral numbering and registry administration services for the telecommunications industry, contracts to serve as the NANPA and PA (including the RNA) beginning January 1, 2019. As part of the Overall Services Transition, the associated people, processes, and Systems (NAS, PAS, RNAS) will transition to Somos, Inc.

The NANPA and PA transition period is in process, on track, and will be completed on January 1, 2019. Please find below the Key Transition Milestones, a high-level view of what's not changing, and what's changing. Additional Reminders and Update Notifications will be sent in accordance with the high-level schedule below.

Key Transition Milestones

- 8pm ET Thursday, December 13th— Moratorium on activity in NAS/PAS in place
- 8am ET Monday, December 17th—Systems cutover to Somos complete, Moratorium ended
Upon system cutover, emails generated from NAS will now show from '@somos.com', however, please continue to send your email correspondences to the Neustar emails through December 31st
- January 2nd—NANPA and PA Services Operations in place

What IS NOT changing during and after the transition

- Any processes associated with the service (e.g. submission of Resource Application, the NRUF Form 502, the NANPA Help Desk)
- NAS Usernames and Passwords

What IS Changing effective January 2, 2019

- Group support and notification email addresses will change from Neustar to a Somos address
