

**608 NPA (Wisconsin)  
Final Jeopardy Procedures**

**NANPA has declared this NPA to be in a Jeopardy situation. The final Jeopardy Procedures have been revised based on Industry consensus in a Jeopardy Review meeting held on October 20, 2022 and codes will be rationed as described below.**

**Lottery Procedures:**

Five (5) requests per OCN can be submitted each month. If five (5) or less Part 1 requests are submitted within the submission timeframe that month then each request receives a CO code. Any part of the base allocation of five (5) that is not assigned in a rationing month **will** carryover for assignment in the following month.

If more than five (5) Part 1 requests are submitted within the submission timeframe that month, the codes will be assigned via a lottery to take place no later than the 10th business day of the month. Code requests that do not receive a code allocation in the current month allocation will be denied and the applicant must submit a new Part 1 request for future month's allocation.
