Subject: NANP - Introduction of New 867 (Yukon & Northwest Territories) Numbering Plan Area (NPA)

At the request of the Canadian government, a new 867 NPA code has been assigned to the Yukon and Northwest Territories. Currently, this territory is being served through central office code assignments (NXXs) in the 819 and 403 NPAs. The assignment of the 867 NPA will realign the boundaries to more clearly reflect the geography of the North.

The introduction of the new 867 NPA, and the beginning of a permissive dialing period, will take place at 12:01 AM Mountain Standard Time (MST) on Tuesday, October 21, 1997. The permissive dialing period will end at 11:59 PM MST on Sunday, April 26, 1998. During the permissive dialing period, calls placed to a number terminating in the new 867 NPA may be dialed using either the new 867 NPA code or may be dialed using either the 403 or 819 NPA codes, depending on the NXX code. After the permissive dialing period, calls dialed to NXXs in the Yukon and Northwest Territories with the 403 or 819 NPAs will be routed to intercept.

All international and domestic carriers are asked to ensure that the new 867 NPA has been activated throughout their networks prior to October 21, 1997. Test calls to verify routing to the new 867 NPA can be made by dialing, 867-669-5448. The test number will be operational from within the 867 NPA on August 1, 1997. It is not expected the test number can be reached from outside the 867 NPA until shortly before the beginning of permissive dialing. Calls successfully completed to the test number will receive a recorded announcement. In the event that calls cannot be completed to numbers in the 867 NPA, please contact one of the following trouble reporting numbers: between 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM MST (Monday to Friday) at 403-669-5447 (voice), or 403-669-7543 (facsimile). The test number and the trouble reporting numbers will be deactivated on April 26, 1998.

Attached is a map showing the geographical area of the new 867 NPA. Also attached is a listing of the communities and the NXXs to be covered by the new 867 NPA.

The dialing plan for the new 867 NPA will remain the same, namely:

- All home NPA (HNPA) "local" calls will be dialed on a 7-digit basis with no prefix; i.e., NXX + XXXX (7 digits). Extended Area Service (EAS) calls are treated as local calls.
- All HNPA "toll" calls, calls that generally incur a charge, will be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits;
 i.e., 1+ HNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + 10 digits).


- All Foreign NPA (FNPA) direct dialed calls will be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits; i.e., 1+ FNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + 10 digits).
- All operator assisted calls, including credit card, collect, and third party calls, will be dialed with a "0" prefix and 10 digits, i.e., 0 + NPA + NXX + XXXX (0 + 10 digits).
