Subject: Important Notice of Delay in Implementation of NPA Relief for the 412 NPA (Pennsylvania)

We have been advised by Bell Atlantic that due to regulatory and judicial intervention the NPA relief plan originally approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PPUC) for the 412 NPA in western Pennsylvania has been halted and will not be implemented on May 1, 1997 as described in Bellcore Planning Letter PL-NANP-018, dated October 31, 1996. The relief plan called for a general purpose overlay in which the new 724 NPA would share the same boundaries as the 412 NPA. It is anticipated that a new relief plan will be developed, subject to regulatory review, but the specific details and implementation schedule are unknown at this time.

Despite this development, Bell Atlantic indicates that all telecommunications providers that access Bell Atlantic's networks must transmit 10 digits to all Bell Atlantic access tandems and end offices, as described in PL-NANP-018.
