Subject: Extraordinary NPA-Specific Jeopardy Conservation Procedures Announced for 813 NPA (Florida)

We have been notified by GTE Florida, the numbering administrator for Florida, that because number demand has increased beyond normal forecasts, the 813 NPA in Florida is in jeopardy of exhausting prior to when relief can be provided. According to the *Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines* (document INC 95-0407-008), "A jeopardy condition exists when the forecasted and/or actual demand for NXX resources will exceed the known supply during the planning/implementation interval for relief." The purpose of this notice is to announce that *extraordinary NPA-specific conservation* measures as defined in Section 8.5 of the guidelines have become necessary for the 813 NPA.

GTE Florida has provided NANPA information about extraordinary NPA-specific conservation procedures that will become effective for the 813 NPA. These procedures have received industry consensus and are being implemented to insure the remaining NXX codes in the 813 NPA best meet the industry and community needs until relief can be provided.

The 813 NPA is currently scheduled for relief on October 4, 1998. In order to ensure code availability in the 813 NPA, the following conservation method will be put in place: Starting with February 1998 assignments, NXX codes will be restricted to 10 per month. These will be issued on a first come, first served basis, with one code per company per month. If the 10 are not used, additional requests from one company will be honored.
